In her current role, Kim is the Technical Officer providing support for remediation projects in several IAEA Member States including Ukraine and Kazakhstan. In her former role, Kim was responsible for developing the UK's approach to identifying and developing the Site End State and included providing technical support to the Sellafield, Winfrith and Dounreay sites.

Kim has a PhD in Environmental Radiochemistry from Loughborough University, she is a Chartered Scientist and Member of the Nuclear Institute and the Royal Society of Chemistry.
