Vincent Ialenti is a MacArthur Assistant Research Professor at George Washington University's Elliott School of International Affairs. He holds a PhD in Anthropology from Cornell University and an MSc in Law, Anthropology & Society from the London School of Economics. His current book project (under contract with MIT Press) explores how safety assessment experts working on Finland's spent nuclear fuel repository project at Olkiluoto grappled with deep time, death, and the limits of human imagination. Vincent has been a U.S. National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellow (2011-2016) and a Mellon Fellow at Cornell's Society for the Humanities (2015-2016). Alongside his academic work, he has written articles for NPR, Forbes, Physics Today, The Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists, and other outlets.
